AMELIA MOVES ON

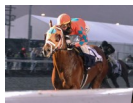

Visitor to PXE

An unusual April visitor to the Perry-Houston County Airport was a Piaggio Avante. The Piaggio P.180 Avanti is an Italian executive transport aircraft with twin turboprop engines mounted in pusher configuration. It seats up to nine people in a pressurized cabin, and may be flown by one or two pilots. With a top speed of 460 mph and a cruising speed of 366 mph, the aircraft has a range of 1,700 miles. Nice little craft to take your family on vacation!
