Perry-Houston County Airport (KPXE) Perry, Georgia

Perry-Houston County Airport (KPXE) has a new 4,600 square foot FBO facility with conference rooms, pilot lounge with shower, quiet room, and a break room with great (free) coffee. A brand-new 11,700 square foot heated hangar can house overnight corporate jets and General Aviation visitors. 56 closed hangars, 10 open T-hangars and seven corporate hangars base 85 aircraft at PXE. The runway (18/36) was just resurfaced and extended to 5,004 feet. Three aircraft maintenance facilities and two flight schools round out the service capabilities.

Corporate regulars at the airport include Cornerstone Flooring, Jack Link's Snacks, Blue Bird Coach, Frito-Lay, Perdue Chicken, Beaux Eden, and others. Visitors can utilize one of three crew cars to visit attractions in the area such as the Museum of Aviation at Robins Air Force Base, Rigby's Water World, Georgia National Fairgrounds and Ag Center, the Go Fish Education Center, Lane Southern Orchards, and the historical Swanson House Restaurant.

The FBO is open every day except for Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's. Full serve Avgas and Jet-A are available from 0800 to 1800, and self-serve 100LL Avgas is available 24/7 at the self-serve pump next to the FBO. The UNICOM frequency is 123.75.
